ART Kaua`i 2023: artist's receipt / exhibition criteria

Artists: You are invited to enter **KSA's 37th Annual Juried Exhibition Art Kaua`i 2023** which features original art from Kaua`i's finest artists. Entry date is **Saturday, Sept 9 (11 am- 5:00 pm)**

The Exhibition runs from **Sept 16 - Oct 27, 2023**. E-mail: artinkauai@gmail.com for more information.

Entries: Entries must be delivered to: KSA Gallery, Kukui Grove Center, Lihue **Sept 9 from 11 to 5:00 pm**.
No late entries accepted. Please arrive by 4:30 pm to finalize the paperwork.

Eligibility: All Kauai resident artists 18 years or older are eligible to enter;
New and returning members may join KSA on entry day.
KSA annual membership dues for individuals are \$35 (other membership categories are available.)

Entries: Artists may enter up to 3 pieces. There is **No Refund** of entry fees for unaccepted work.

Fees: \$10.00 for each entry (\$30 for 3 entries) and confirmation or renewal of 2023 KSA membership fee.

Criteria: **PLEASE read the criteria thoroughly.** All artwork is subject to the following criteria:

1. Art must be original and independently created by artist or collaboration of artists, **within the last three years.**
2. No student work created in a classroom or under an instructor's direction will be accepted.
3. Dimensions: no larger than 6x6 feet; weight no greater than 20 pounds for wall-hung art and no greater than 200 pounds for free-standing art. Art exceeding 20 pounds that is not free-standing will be considered but must have its own easel or other appropriate support, and may require the artist be responsible for hanging. 4. **Copies or reproductions of works originally created in a different medium** are not allowed, unless reproduction is an integral part of a new artistic or conceptual statement.
5. Work previously shown in a KSA show is **NOT** eligible.
6. All work must be complete, dry and ready for installation. No dirty mats or glass, unframed canvas with staples showing, poorly constructed framing or temporary methods of display such as "shrink-wrap", etc.
7. All **wall-hung pieces must have hanging wire securely attached—no saw-tooth hangers.**
KSA does not provide hanging wire or screws.
8. The Kukui Grove Center Management prohibits the display of the unclothed human form or any work that they consider obscene. KSA reserves the right to not accept work considered inappropriate, incomplete or unsafe.

Sales & Commission: Artists are encouraged to offer their work for sale. While not a requirement, a focus of this show is to offer artists and the buying public sales opportunities; **25% of the sale price is to be donated to KSA.**

Publicity: Artists agree that KSA may use images of works from the show in publicity and show promotion, such as newspapers, newsletters and the KSA website. Full copyright and acknowledgement is given when possible.

Show Sitting and Deposit: All participating artists are required to show sit at least two show sitting sessions or pay a **\$60 show sitting fee.**

Pickup of Work: Accepted Work will be posted on the KSA website (www.kauaisocietyofartists.org) early on **Monday, Sept 11** - If your work isn't on the list, please pick it up that day or call 808-228-9624.

Pick-up at the end of the exhibition is Sat., Oct 28 from Noon – 4 pm or by appointment.
KSA is not responsible for work left after pickup deadlines.
